## 1st Quarter, 2019 Container Notice

- Remember not to overfill or stuff your containers.
- **Lids must be able to close.** If the container is overfull and the lid can not close, then debris from the can will spill out before it can be dumped into the truck.
- **Overfull containers may not be picked-up.**

## Let's talk about Household Hazardous Waste



Here are some tips for recognizing the difference between regular trash and what is considered household hazardous waste (HHW).

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is any product that contains toxic, poisonous, corrosive or flammable ingredients. Products used to clean, paint, and disinfect your home are HHW, as are many auto, beauty, landscaping, yard, and workshop products. Common HHW products include: batteries, nail polish, spot removers, sharps and medications, aerosol cans with contents, batteries (all), household cleaning products, spot remover, oven cleaners, pool chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, fertilizer, wood preservatives, old paint, varnish, paint stripper, tar, thermostats, gasoline, transmission fluid, brake fluid, and propane tanks.

Certain HHW products require special handling and disposal. These include florescent bulbs, sharps, medications, and e-waste. Fresno County, in partnership with the 15 incorporated cities throughout Fresno County, offers a program to County residents known as the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Network. The HHW Network is a collection of local drop-off sites that collect the five most common types of HHW: paint, household batteries, sharps, fluorescent tubes and bulbs, and e-waste. **It is illegal to place household hazardous waste into trash containers.** Remember that when you toss HHW items into the trash, you are polluting the valley's air, soil and water with toxic, dangerous materials, and **HHW can cause fires—in the truck or at the facility where your trash is processed, causing serious injuries and death to workers.**

## Vamos a hablar de Desechos Peligrosos del Hogar



Desechos Peligrosos del Hogar (HHW) es cualquier producto que contenga ingredientes tóxicos, venenosos, corrosivos o inflamables. Los productos utilizados para limpiar, pintar, y desinfectar su hogar son HHW, al igual que algunos productos de belleza, jardinería, jardín, taller y productos automotrices. Los productos comunes HHW incluyen:

Baterías, esmalte de uñas, quitamanchas, latas de aerosol con contenidos, productos de limpieza del hogar, quitamanchas, limpiadores de horno, productos químicos para piscinas, pesticidas herbicidas fertilizantes, conservantes de madera, pintura vieja, barnices, separador de pintura, alquitrán, termostatos, la gasolina, la transmisión fluido, líquido de tanques propano.

Ciertos productos HHW requieren un manejo y disposición especial. Éstos incluyen Bombillas fluorescentes, objetos punzantes, medicamentos y residuos electrónicos.

Es ilegal colocar los artículos anteriores en la basura. Recuerde que cuando usted lanza artículos HHW en la basura, que está contaminando el aire, el suelo del valle y el agua con, materiales peligrosos tóxicos y **HHW puede causar incendios, en el camión o en las instalaciones donde se procesa su basura, causando lesiones graves y la muerte de los trabajadores.**
